Ladies and Gentlemen,

Good Shepherd Parish Knights of Columbus Council 9076 has scheduled the arrival of an Icon of Our Lady of Guadalupe for February 19, 2012. The Icon—which has been touched to the Tilma, contains soil from Tepeyac and has been blessed by Pope Benedict XVI—is considered a third degree relic. It will be in the parish until Sunday, February 26, to encourage participation in the Knights of Columbus Our Lady of Guadalupe Prayer Program. The program seeks to promote Marian Prayer and recognize Our Lady of Guadalupe as patroness of all the Americas and the Philippines. The Icon will be available during the week for prayer and meditation in the Blessed Sacrament Chapel of the church. If Good Shepherd School wishes to hold a prayer service there are prayer program booklets that travel with the Icon that will be available. Scheduling may be accomplished through the Parish Office. The Icon will be accompanied by a member of the Knights of Columbus.
